- Responsible for creating detailed and effective lesson plans in accordance with Grace Bible Academy's selected curriculum.
- Display the love of Jesus Christ in words, actions, and attitudes to all children.
- Effectively discipline children in accordance with biblical principles
- Review all curriculum used by Grace Bible Academy and ensures they are consistent with the church's doctrinal commitments.
- Be responsible for continual evaluation of students and recommend remediation as necessary.

## REQUIREMENTS

- A bachelor's degree (preferably in early childhood education, elementary education, or Christian ministry). Master of divinity preferred.
- 3 years of experience in early childhood education, elementary education preferred

- Ability to pass a background check.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Understanding of and willingness to serve within the doctrinal commitments of the church.
